

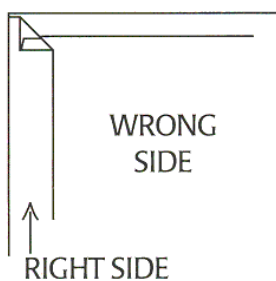
## "Bob the Builder™ Wall Hanging"

### Materials Needed:

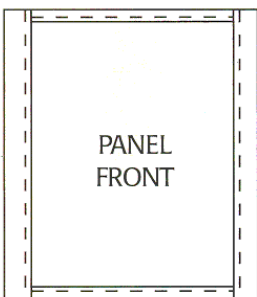
Wall Hanging Panel		
Fabric for Backing	1 1/2 yds.	1005/61267-B
Batting	1 /2 yd.	1005/61271 -B

### Instructions:

1. Cut out the wall hanging panel.
2. Measure the 1 large square on the panel and cut 1 piece of batting the size of your measurement.
3. Measure the 4 small squares on the panel and cut out 4 pieces of batting this size.
4. Place the batting on the corresponding squares on the wrong side of the panel. Pin them in place but place the pins on the right side of the fabric.
5. Measure the panel. Measure the backing fabric to fit the panel but add 3" to the length measurement and 6" to the width measurement. Cut this piece out.
6. Press under 1-1/2" along the upper edge of the wall hanging pressing under 1/2" along raw edge. Repeat with the lower edge.

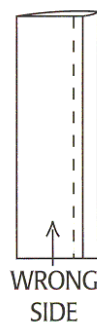


7. Press under 3" along the length of the wall hanging pressing under 1/2" along the raw edge. Repeat with the opposite side.
8. Center the panel on the wrong side of the backing fabric then fold the pressed edges onto the panel and pin in place.

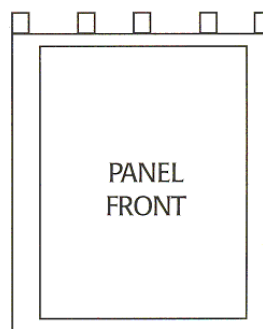


9. Stitch close to inner pressed edge.
10. Stitch around the squares.

11. For the loops cut 5 pieces of fabric 2" X 6". Fold in half, right sides together and stitch the one long side. Turn and press.



12. Measure and mark the top center of the wall hanging. Sew 1 tab in the top center on the back of the wall hanging and 1 on each end.
13. Mark the center between the ends and the center on each side and sew tabs on.



## "Bob the Builder™ Pillow"

### Materials Needed:

Pillow Panel		1005/61268-B
Backing Fabric	1/2 yd.	1005/61272-B
Polyfill		

### Instructions:

1. Cut out the pillow panel.
2. Pin the panel right sides together to the backing fabric. Cut the backing fabric the same size as the panel.
3. Stitch around all four sides leaving a 5" opening in the bottom for turning. Diagonally trim corners. Turn and press.
4. Stuff the pillow and hand sew opening closed.
