



BULLETIN BOARD

Finished Size: 20" x 30"

Materials:

Foam Board	1/4" Thick	2 - 20" x 30" Pcs.
International Harvester Polyester Fleece	# 62645-G	1 1/2 Yds.
Grosgrain Ribbon	1/4"	1 Yd.
Grosgrain Ribbon	5/8"	10 Yds.
Glue Gun/Glue Sticks		
Push Pins		

Instructions:

1. Trace foam board around the edges on the wrong side of fabric. Add 2" to the outside of this line and cut out. Cut a second piece of the fabric this same size for the back.
2. Trace the foam board on to the fleece and cut on this line.
3. Glue the fleece to one piece of the foam board.
4. Center the foam board on the wrong side of the fabric with the fleece side down. Turn the edges of the fabric over the board to the back, folding in the corners, and glue down.

5. With a disappearing ink pen or light pencil, mark the front of the board diagonally every 6 3/4" in both directions.
6. Cut the 5/8" ribbon to fit each line adding 1 1/2" at start and finish to turn to the back.
7. Lay the ribbon across the board in one direction first, placing drop of glue at the start and end of each row. Repeat in the other direction.

8. Glue the ends of the ribbon down on the back of the board.
9. Mark the center top of the back of the board and 2" in from each side. Cut the 1/4" ribbon into three 10" pieces.
10. Fold in half bringing the ends together to form loops and glue the ribbon to the back of the board at the marks.
11. Repeat step 4 with the other fabric and board omitting the fleece. Glue the boards together. Place push pins at all the intersecting points.

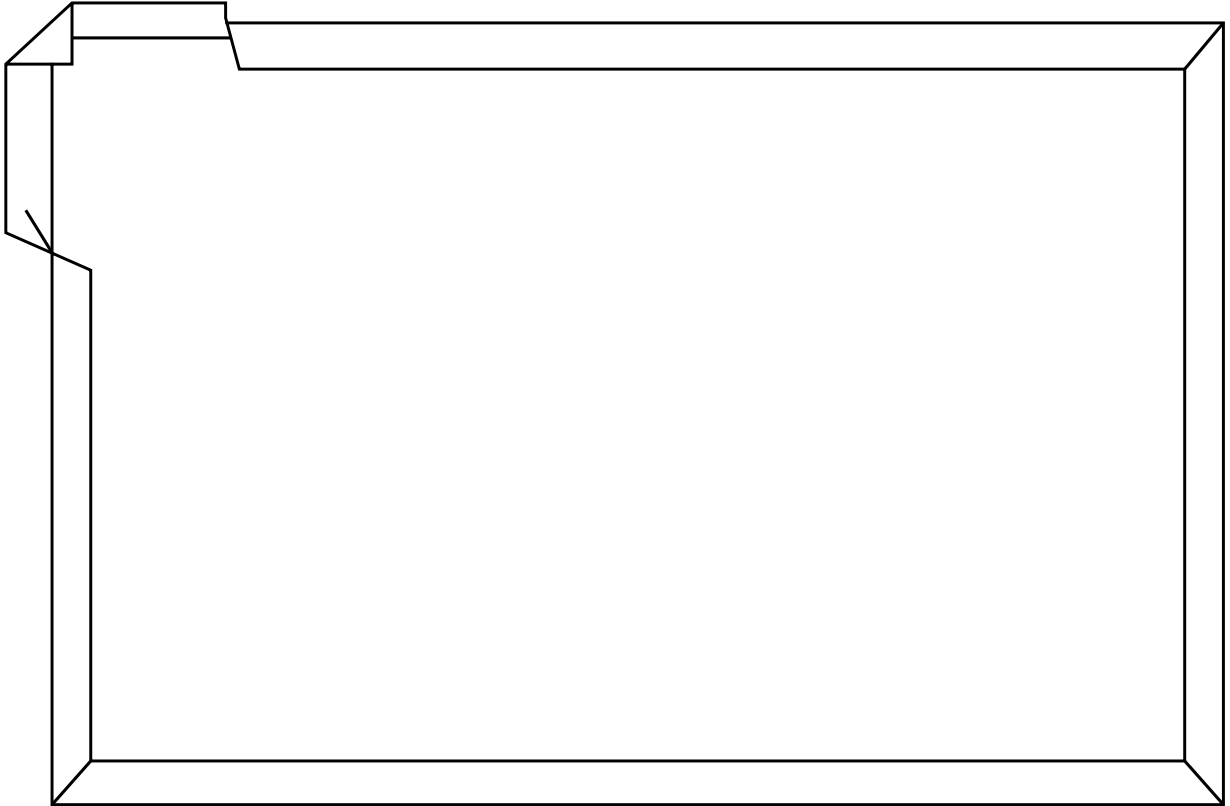
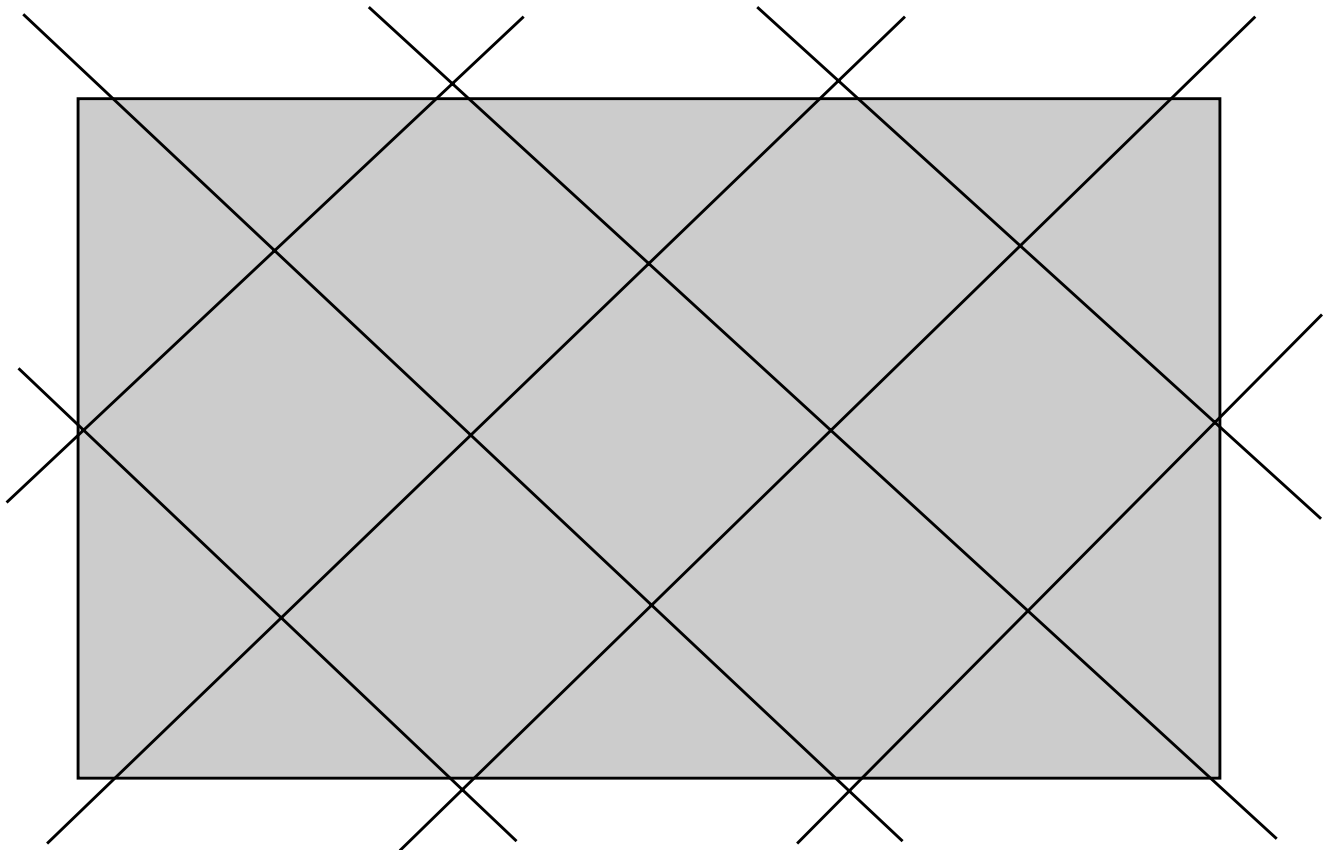
