



Bulletin Board

Read all instructions carefully. 1/2" seam allowance included in all measurements.

Finished size: 20" x 30"

Materials Needed:

Foam Board	1/4" Thick	2-20" X 30" Pcs
Mary's Mottos Fabric	VIP #61118-S	1 1/2 Yds
Polyester Fleece		1/2 Yd
Braid	1/2 "	10 Yds
Grosgrain Ribbon	1/4"	1 Yd
Glue Gun/Glue Sticks		
Push Pins		

1. Trace foam board around edges on the wrong side of fabric. Add 2" to the outside of this line and cut out. Cut a second piece of fabric this size for the back.
2. Trace the foam board on to the fleece and cut on this line.
3. Glue the fleece to one piece of foam board.
4. Center the foam board on the wrong side of the fabric with the fleece side down. Turn the edges of the fabric over the board, folding in corners, and glue down. **Illustration 1**
5. With a disappearing pen or light pencil, mark the front of the board diagonally every 5" in both directions.
6. Cut the braid to fit each line adding 1 1/2" at start and finish to turn toward the back.
7. Lay the braid across the board in one direction first, placing a drop of glue at the start and end of each row and at each intersecting point. Repeat in the other direction placing a drop of glue on the braid where the lines cross. **Illustration 2**
8. Glue the ends of the braid down on the back of the board.
9. Mark the center top of the back of the board and 2" in from each side. Cut 3 pieces of ribbon 10" each. Fold in half bringing ends together to form loop and glue the loop to the back of the board at your marks.
10. Repeat step 4 with the other fabric and board omitting fleece.
11. Glue the boards together.
12. Place push pins in intersecting points.

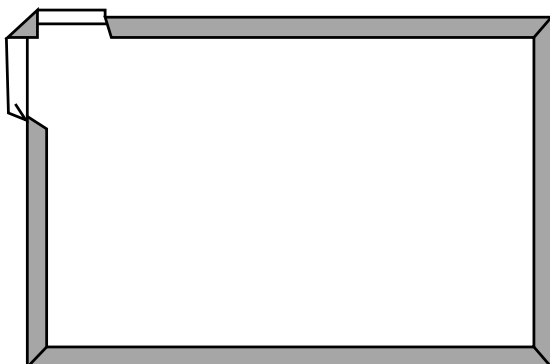

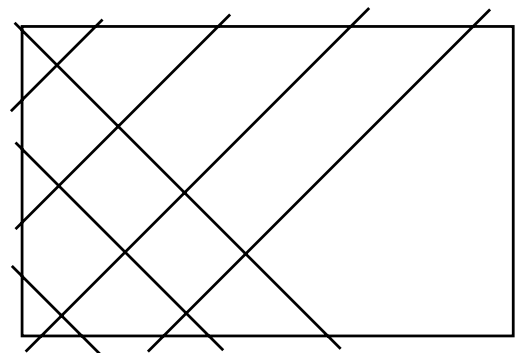
