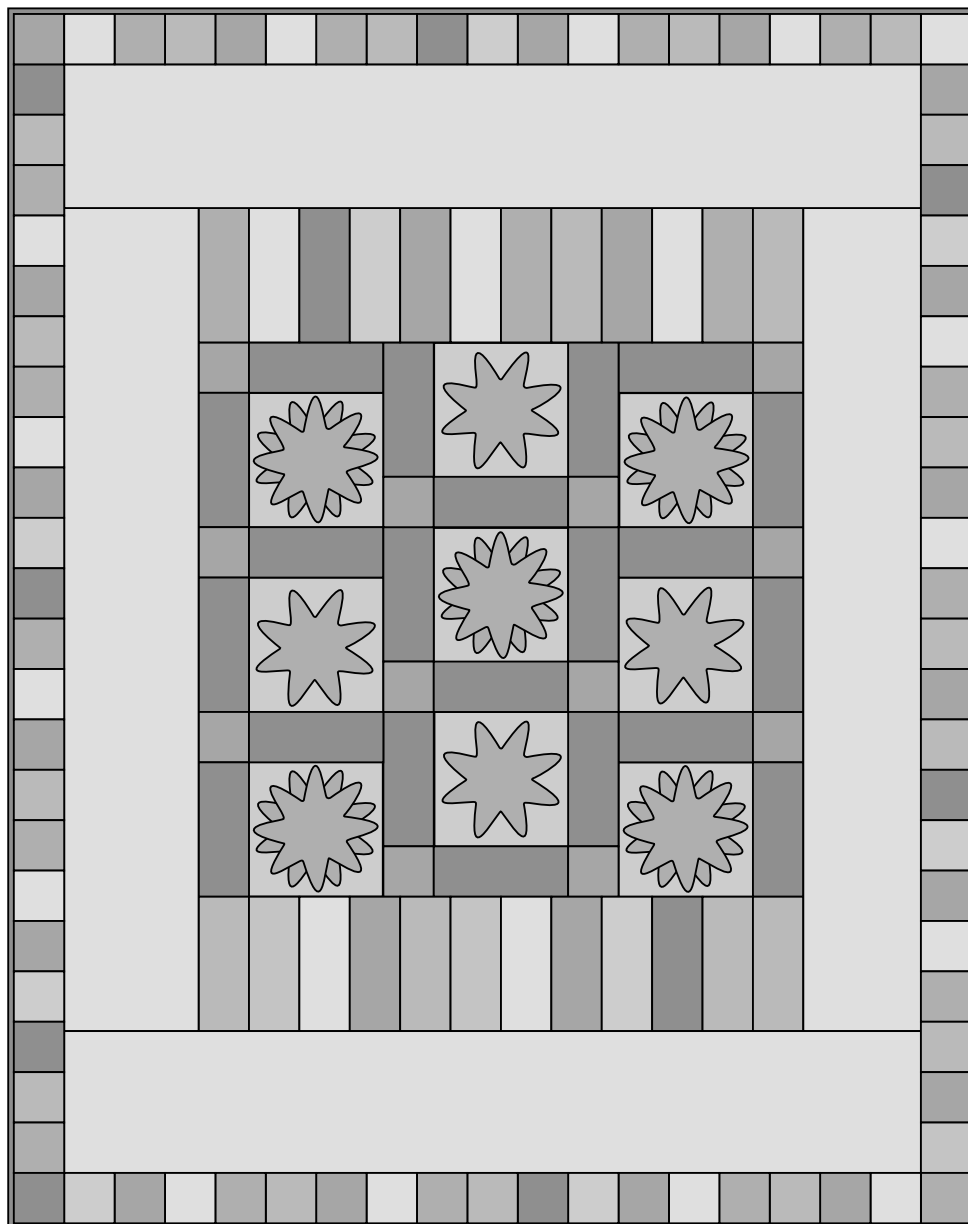

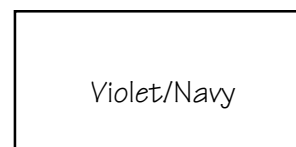

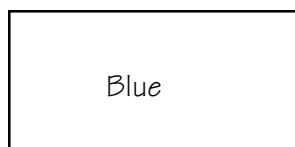

Cutting Instructions

Yellow/Pink

2 - 4 1/4" x 25" strips
2 - 4 3/4" x 30" strips
5 - 2" x 4 1/2" pieces
1 - 2" x 42" strip

Orange

2 - 4 1/2" x 42" strips
2 - 2" x 4 1/2" pieces
1 - 2" x 42" strip

Pink/Purple

6 - 2" x 4 1/2" pieces
1 - 2" x 42" strip
14 - Referring to Manufacturer's Instructions trace and cut flower templates

Violet/Navy

2 - 2" x 4 1/2" pieces
1 - 4 1/2" x 42" strips
3 - 2" x 42" strip
4 - 2 1/2" x 42" strips (binding)

Red

4 - 2" x 4 1/2" pieces
3 - 2" x 42" strips

Blue

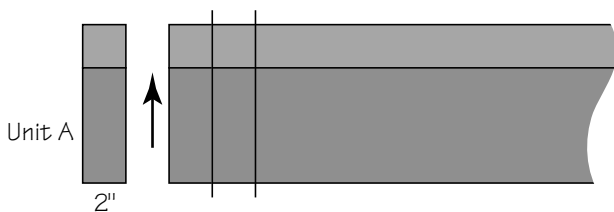
5 - 2" x 4 1/2" pieces
1 - 2" x 42" strip

Red/Blue

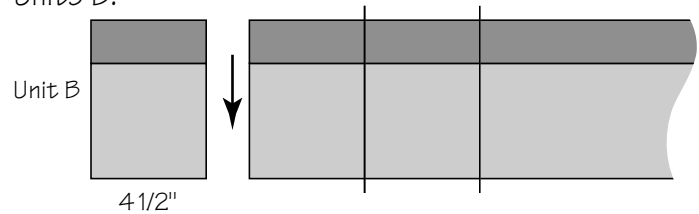
1 - 35" x 42" piece (backing)

Sewing (Arrows indicate pressing direction)

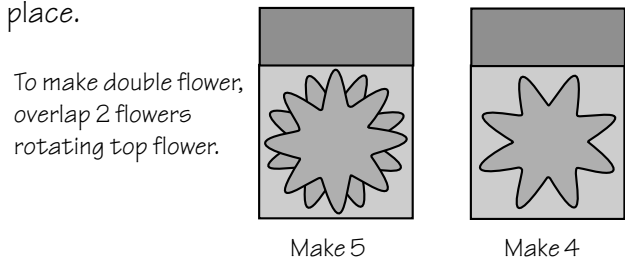
1. Using 4 1/2" x 42" Violet/Navy strip and 2" x 42" Red strip, make one strip set. Cut 12 - 2" Units A.



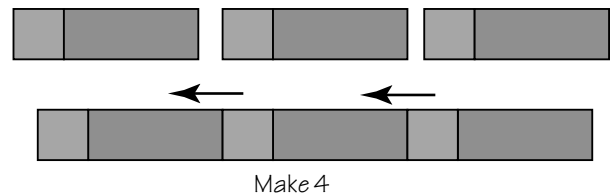
2. Using 4 1/2" x 42" Orange strips and 2" x 42" Violet/Navy strips, make two strip sets. Cut 9 - 4 1/2" Units B.



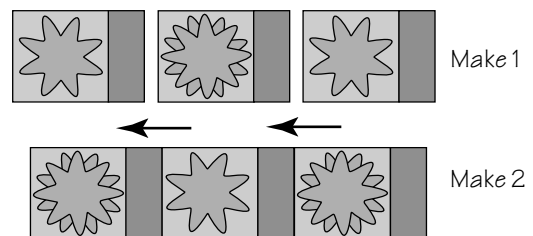
A. Following Manufacturer's Instructions, center and fuse flowers to Units B. Hand or machine button hole in place.



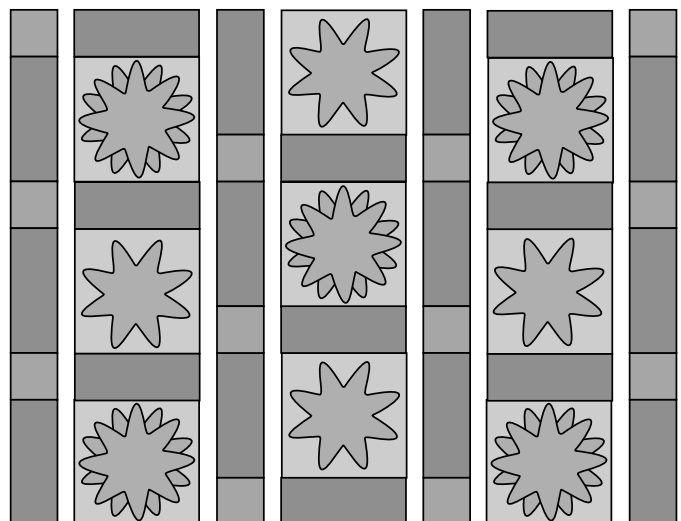
3. Sew 3 Units A together.



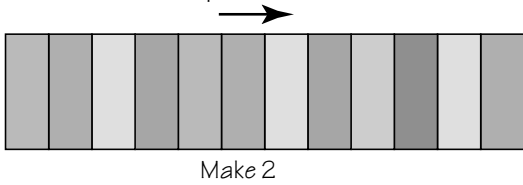
4. Sew 3 Units B together. Note placement of flowers.



5. Join rows using Units A & B.

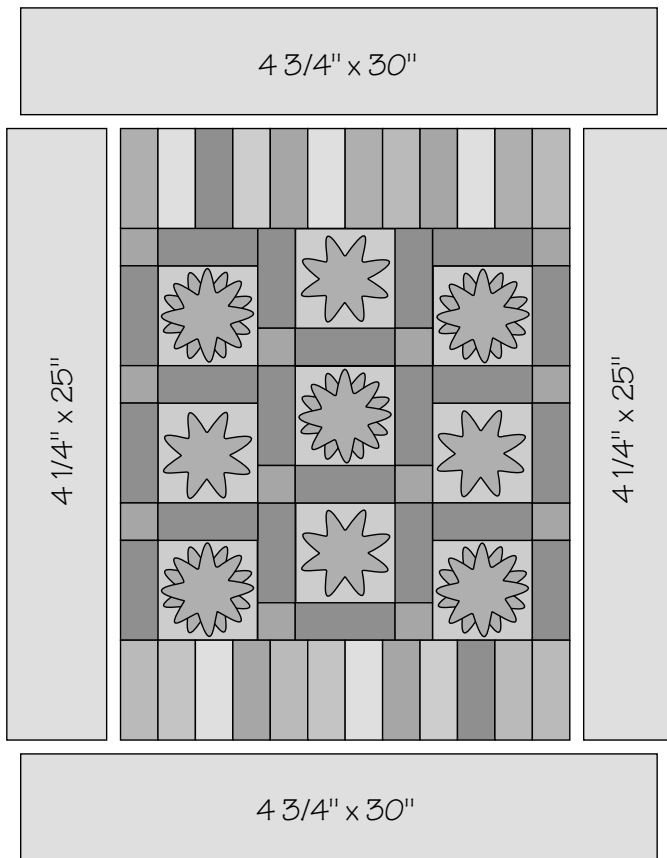


6. For color placement, randomly sew (or refer to color photo) 2" x 4 1/2" pieces together to make top and bottom strips.

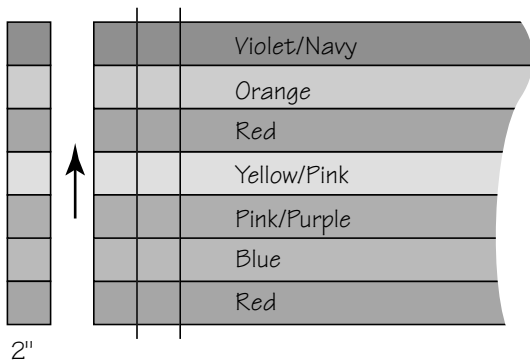


A. Sew to top and bottom of pieced center.

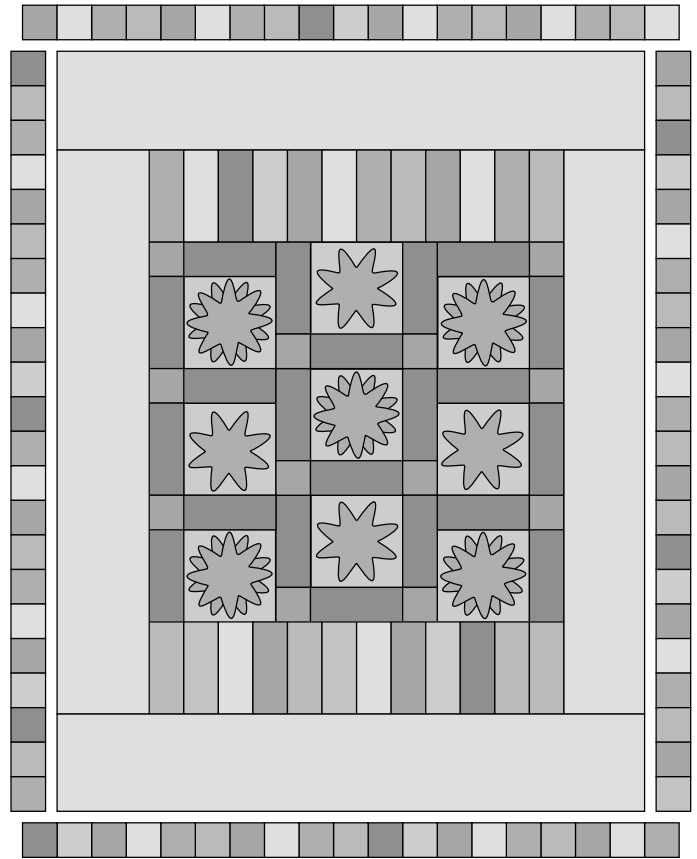
7. Add Yellow/Pink borders, sides first, then top and bottom.



8. Use remaining 2" x 42" strips to make one strip set. Cut into 12 - 2" Units.



A. For color placement, randomly sew (or refer to color photo) strip sets to make 2 - 22 count side borders and 2 - 19 count top and bottom borders.
Remove stitches and sew units back together to get a more scrappy look.
Add to quilt top, sides first, then top and bottom.
