

# Harvest Decoupage Tray

## Materials Needed:

Unfinished oval wooden tray

(approx: 16 1/2 X 9 1/2)

1/3 Yard Harvest Print Fabric -

Pattern 72585 Color E

Plaid Glaze: Olde World Bronze

Aleene's Instant Decoupage Matte Finish

Foam Brush



- 1) Dilute Glaze: 1 Tbs. to 3 Tbs. of water and mix. Stain the inside and outside of the tray and allow to dry.
- 2) Cut out the motif from the fabric. Cut out the other pieces like leaves, grapes and acorns.
- 3) Position the fabric on the tray in a design of your choice. You can place the other pieces coming out from under the motif and also on top.
- 4) Carefully remove the fabric and place it on top of the table the way you had it on the tray.
- 5) Coat the whole top and insides of the tray with decoupage. Coat the back of each fabric piece with decoupage and reposition it on the tray. Smooth out any bumps or air bubbles with a wet finger. Allow it to dry.
- 6) Coat the whole tray with another coat of decoupage and allow to dry.
