

Harvest Placemat with Pocket

Pattern Level: Intermediate

Finished size: 19 1/2" x 11"

Seam allowances: 1/4" Seam allowance has been included in the measurements.



Materials needed:

1/2 Yd Beige Leaf Fabric- Pattern 72587 Color E

1/2 Yd Solid to match Small pieces of Black Leaf Print

1/4 Yd (or 1 square) of Pumpkin Fabric

1/2 Yd Fleece

Cutting:

Pumpkin fabric:

Piece A 1 pc 4 1/2 X 4 1/2

Solid fabric:

B Side strip (of block) 4 pcs 4 1/2 X 1"

E Side bands 2 pcs 12 X 2 1/2

Beige leaf fabric:

C Corner square 4 pcs 1 X 1

D Placemat 1 pc 16 X 12

Instructions:

- 1) Cut all pieces out.
- 2) Sew piece E to each short side of piece D.
- 3) Make block for pocket. (Fig. 1)
 1. Using pieces A and B, sew piece B to each side of piece A.
- 4) Using pieces B and C sew piece C to each end of piece B. (Fig. 2)

- 5) Sew 1 strip to top and one to bottom of piece A (Fig. 3)
- 6) Place block right sides together on a piece of left over fabric.
- 7) Turn, hand stitch opening closed and press.
- 8) Place pocket face up on placemat 1" from edge and 1" from bottom corner. Top stitch around leaving top open.
- 9) Place fleece on table, place backing fabric face up over it. Put placemat on top face down. Pin the pieces together and cut so they are the same size.
- 10) Sew around 4 sides leaving open on 1 side 4". Turn and Press.

Single Sided Napkin

Finished size: 17" x 17"

Materials needed:

½ Yd. - Beige Leaf Print- Pattern 72587 Color E

Instructions:

- 1) Cut fabric 18" X 18"
- 2) Turn under 1/2" for 1/4" hem.
