

Reversible Table Runner

Size: 12" x 32½"

Materials: 7 coordinating fat quarters (18" x 22" cuts)

Cutting:

Red

Cut 10 strips 2" x 9½"

Cream

Cut 4 strips 2½" x 14½"

Cut 2 strips 2½" x 9½"

Cut (8) 2" squares

Brown

Cut 3 strips 1½" x 22", sub cut into 12 – 1½" x 4½" pieces

Cut 6 – 2½" squares

Gold

Cut 3 - 1½" squares

Cut remaining into 3" wide strips for binding

Blue tractor print

Cut 4 – 4½" squares

Gold tractor print

Cut 4 – 4½" squares

Green farm scene

Cut 4 – 4½" squares

Horse print

Cut 2 - 9" x 22" pieces, join along 9" edge and sub cut to 9" x 29½"



Side 1

"Window" Blocks (Make 1 blue, 1 gold, 1 green)

1. Sew 4½" squares to each side of a brown strip, press toward brown strip (Fig. 1)

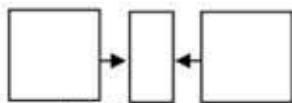

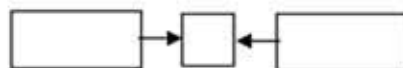

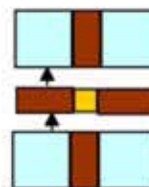

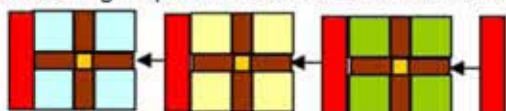
2. Sew brown strips to each side of a gold square (Fig. 2)
3. Sew "window" block together. (Fig. 3)

Sashing

Sew cream 2" squares to 3 red strips. Press seams toward red strips. Make 2 sashing strips.



Sew red sashing strips to window blocks. Press seams toward red strips.



Sew sashing strips to top and bottom of 'window' block unit.

Side 2

1. Sew 2 cream 2" x 9½" strips to the horse unit.

Sashing

Sew 3 brown 2" squares to the cream 2½" x 14½" strips to form sashing as shown below. Make 2



Sew sashing strips to top and bottom of horse unit.
Layer, quilt and bind.
