

Star Placemats and Napkins

Pattern Level: Easy

Seam Allowance:

1/4" used throughout.

Finished size:

18" x 18"



**Materials Needed (for 2
placemats and 2 napkins):**

1 1/4-yard star print

1 1/4-yard polyester fleece

1/2-yard patch print (napkins)

Matching thread

Cutting and Assembly:

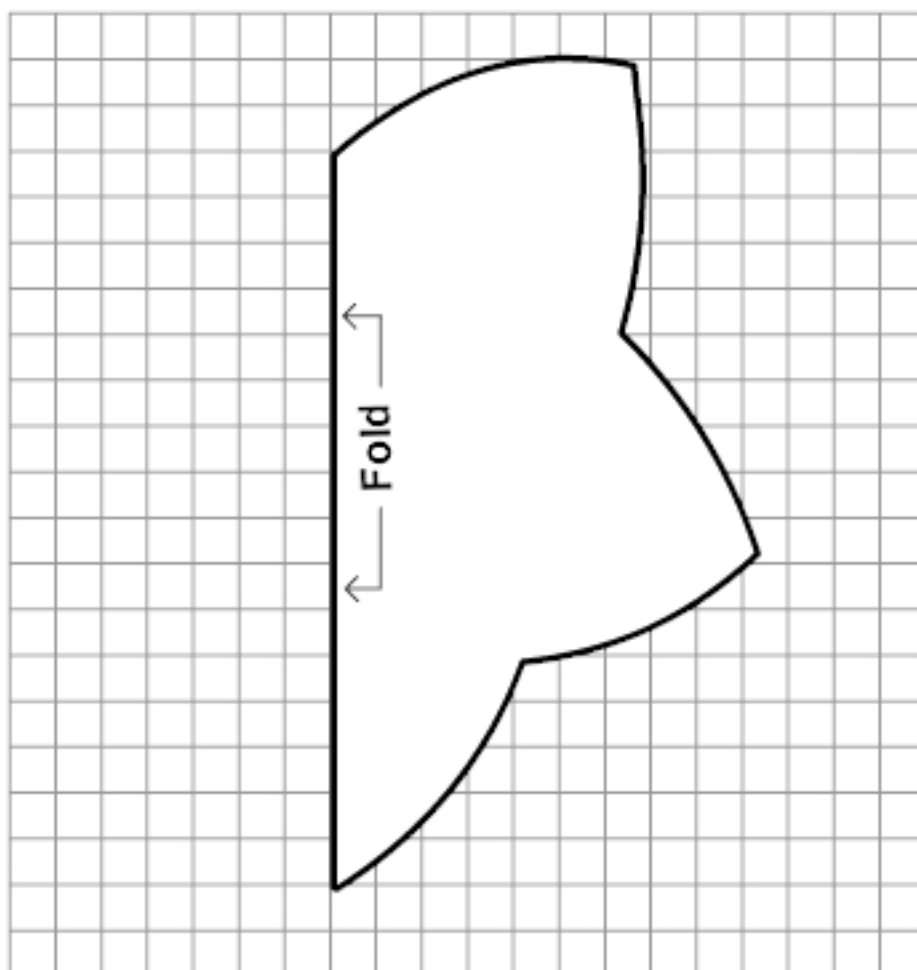
1. Enlarge star pattern using a copier or other method until each background square equals 1". For each placemat cut 2 stars from fabric (place pattern on fold to cut as indicated) and 1 star of fleece.
2. Pin 2 stars right sides facing on top of fleece and stitch around all edges leaving an opening for turning. Clip corners and turn right side out. Stitch opening closed. Press. Topstitch 1/4" from all outside edges.
3. Napkins: For each napkin cut 1 square 15". Narrow hem edges by turning under 1/4" and then turning under 1/4" again and stitching close to edges. Or for a quicker finish, simply pink edges with pinking shears.
