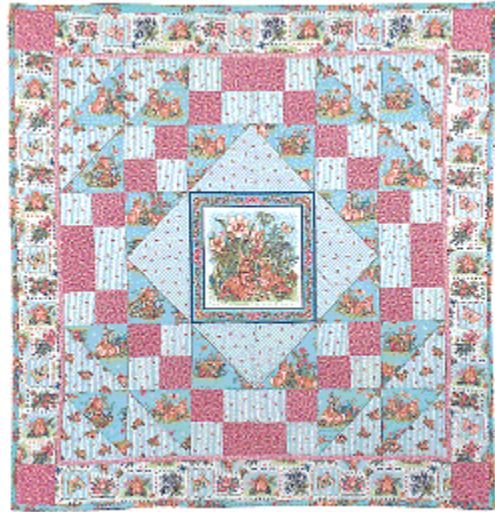

Finished size 53"x53" Pattern Level: Easy -

Some patchwork experience helpful

1/4" Seam allowance included



Materials needed:

- 1/2 yd. V1115-B Pillow panel center
- 3-2/3 yds. V1116-B (ribbon patchwork) for borders and backing
- 1-1/2 yds. V1117-B (bunnies on blue background) "A" triangles and binding
- 1/3 yd. V1118-B (ticking stripe with bunnies) "A" triangles
- 1 yd. V1119-B (ticking stripe with rosebuds) "B" squares and "A" triangles
- 2/3 yd. 0194-P ("Textures" pink) "B" squares, border and 5-1/2" corner squares
- Twin size batt, matching threads

Templates or rotary cut shapes:

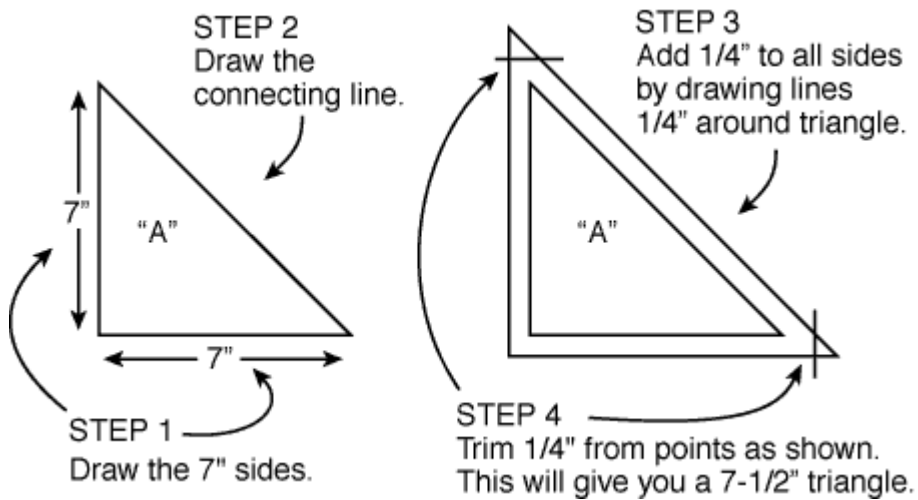
- "A" 7-1/2" right isosceles triangle
- "B" 4" square

Cutting:

Please refer to diagram and photograph.

cutting measurements for A, B and Center are on diagram. Cut borders after you have pieced top. Note that 2 borders are cut crosswise and one lengthwise.

A reminder: Measure your completed pieced top and adjust border cutting measurements if your work requires it.

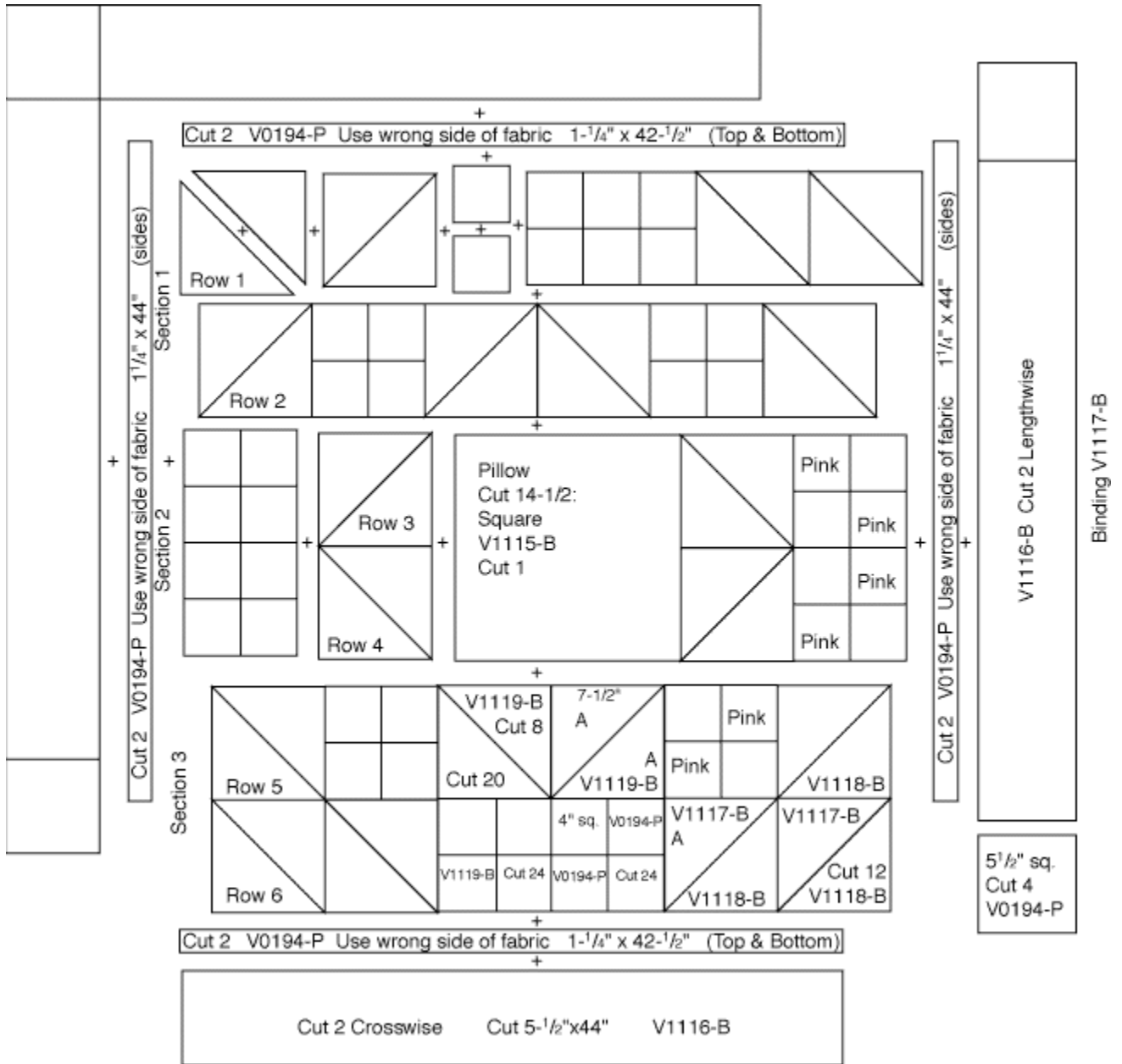


Assembly:

Again refer to diagram for order of piecing. Rows 1 and 2 are sewn together (section 1), rows 3 and 4 are sewn together (section 2), rows 5 and 6 repeat rows 1 and 2 (section 3).

When borders have been added and top is complete, cut backing (it will have to be pieced) and batting approximately 3" larger than top on all sides. Assemble the quilt by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and baste or pin securely. Machine quilt in all seam lines with monofilament thread in the needle and matching thread for back in the bobbin. Some outline quilting in pillow center is necessary. When quilting is complete, trim excess batting and backing. Bind with V1117-B.
