

Back to School No Sew Book Covers

Your child will be the talk of the school with these sturdy book covers- make one for each subject!

Pattern Level: Very Easy – No Sew.

Finished Size: 1 Book cover (average)-13 1/2"x 24", 1 book cover (large)- 15"x 26"



Supplies needed:

1/2-yard cotton print for each book cover (we used a space print and a dragon fly print)

1 package Heat n' Bond Iron-on Vinyl

Assembly:

- 1) For average size book cover cut 1 piece of fabric 13 1/2" x 24". Cut a piece of iron –on vinyl the same size. Follow manufacturer's instructions for applying vinyl to the right side of the fabric.
- 2) Fold book cover around book by laying book cover on table wrong sides up. Place book on book cover. Fold long top and bottom edges to the same size as book. Open book and fold remaining side edges into flaps to fit the book. Insert cover of book into side flaps and tape flap to out side of book cover to hold in place.
- 3) Repeat steps to make larger size cover but cut the fabric and vinyl pieces each- 15"x 26".
