



Comfee Cover

Add color and flair to an old quilt by converting it into a comfee, a creative cover that transforms any favorite quilt or comforter into a fresh new design for beds or as a throw for the couch.

Comfee Size

47" x 55"

Skill Level

Intermediate

Materials Needed

V.I.P.® by Cranston® Mary Engelbreit® Royal Stuff fabric 1005/61335-J (black) and Mary Engelbreit® Yellow Allover 1005 61336-S (yellow)

12 1/2 yards fabric-covered cording in contrasting fabric
Floss



Create your patterns

1. Front panels:

Cut 2 panels 12 3/4" x 56"

Cut 1 panel 24 1/2" x 56"

Apply cording to seams and sew the three pieces together along fabric length.

2. Back panels:

Cut same sized panels as the front, but reverse the fabric colors. Apply cording as above and sew.

3. Pin cording to front panel. Apply top panel to bottom panel and stitch around 4 sides, leaving a 20" opening along one side.

4. Insert comforter through opening and slip- stitch seams closed.

5. Anchor the comforter and cover together with tied floss.
