ALL STAR KIDS QUILT

Pattern: Beginner Level

Materials Needed:

Log Cabin Centers: 1-1/2 yard boys sports block fabric, 1/4 yard of 15-20 assorted sports and basic fabrics for log cabin stripping.

1st Border: 1/2 yard black dot fabric.

2nd Border: 3 yards boys repeating stripe border print fabric. You can get by with 2 yards if you don't care which team goes around the outside edge.

Cutting:

Fussy cut: (20) 7" squares for centers of each log cabin block using all star sports fabric. (To fussy cut you center your square where you want on your fabric motif so that you get the fabric section you want.)

Log Cabin Stripping: From each 1/4 yard piece cut 4 strips of fabric 1-1/2" x 44" long.

1st Border: Cut (6) 2-1/2" x 44" strips of black dot fabric and sew them into (2) 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" black dot fabric strips for sides and (2) 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" black dot fabric strips for top and bottom of quilt.

Block Construction:

Log Cabin Blocks: A log cabin block is made by sewing strips around a center square. Stitch 1-1/2" strips around all star sports fabric center square trimming off excess fabric as you go. Repeat this process until you have 3 strips sewn on all sides. See **diagram A**. Make 20 blocks following this method. Your squares should now be 12-1/2". See photo.

Quilt Construction:

Lay out blocks 4 across by 5 down. Sew blocks together using photo for placement.

1st Border: Sew (2) 2-1/2" x 60" strips of black dot fabric to sides of quilt and sew (2) 2-1/2" x 52-1/2" strips of black dot fabric to top and bottom of quilt.

2nd Border: Sew (2) 6-3/4" x 64-1/2" strips of boys repeating stripe fabric to sides of quilt. Sew (1) 6-3/4" green dot square to each end of the remaining 6-3/4" x 52-1/2" strips of boys repeating stripe fabric. Sew the 2 finished strips to top and bottom of quilt. See photo.

Finishing:

Layer quilt top batting and quilt back and machine or hand quilt. Sew royal blue binding strips together and bind quilt.

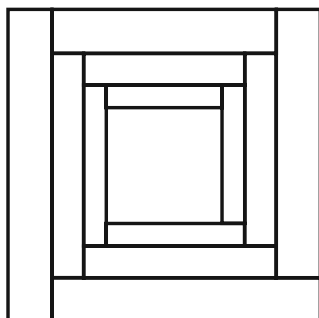

2nd Border Corner Posts: 1/4 yard green dot.

Appliques: 1/4 yard yellow dot and 1/4 yard aqua dot.

Backing: 4-2/3 yards sports ball toss blue.

Binding: 2/3 yard royal blue dot.

2nd Border: Hand cut (2) 6-3/4" x 64-1/2" strips from boys repeating stripe fabric paying special attention to connecting borders to make sure you have space above and below the team for your seam allowance for sides of quilt. Following same process hand cut (2) 6-3/4" x 52-1/2" strips from boys repeating stripe fabric for top and bottom of quilt.

2nd Border Corner Posts: Cut (4) 6-3/4" x 6-3/4" squares green dot for corner posts.

Binding: Cut (7) 2-1/2" x 44" strips of royal blue dot.

Applique Blocks: Using the star pattern trace 4 large stars and 4 small stars on to fusible webbing. Cut webbing slightly larger than drawn image. Fuse and cut out 4 large stars from yellow dot fabric and 4 small stars from aqua dot fabric. Center and fuse the stars to the 6-3/4" x 6-3/4" green dot fabric. Machine applique around stars.
