



REVERSIBLE FARMERS APRON

Materials:

International Harvester Barnboard Patch

62164R

Apron Front 1 Yd.

International Harvester Scenic

62624G

Apron Back and Ties 1 Yd.

2 – 1" D Rings

Seam allowance included in all pieces.

Note: Use 1/2" seam allowance throughout unless otherwise specified.



Instructions:

1. Following the cutting diagram, cut the apron front only from the Barnboard Patch. Cut the apron back and four ties from the Harvester Scenic fabric. Cut 4" from one tie piece for the short neck strap and discard the remaining piece.

2. Fold tie right sides together and stitch tie along one long edge and one short edge, using a 1/4" seam. Turn the tie right side out and press. Repeat with the remaining ties. Fold the short tie in half over the D-Rings and stitch close to the D-rings.

3. Stitch the ties to the apron front at the markings, lining up the raw edges of the straps with the raw edge of the apron.
4. Place apron front and back right sides together. Stitch, keeping ties free and leaving opening for turning at bottom.
5. Turn and press.
6. Top stitch 1/4" from all edges.

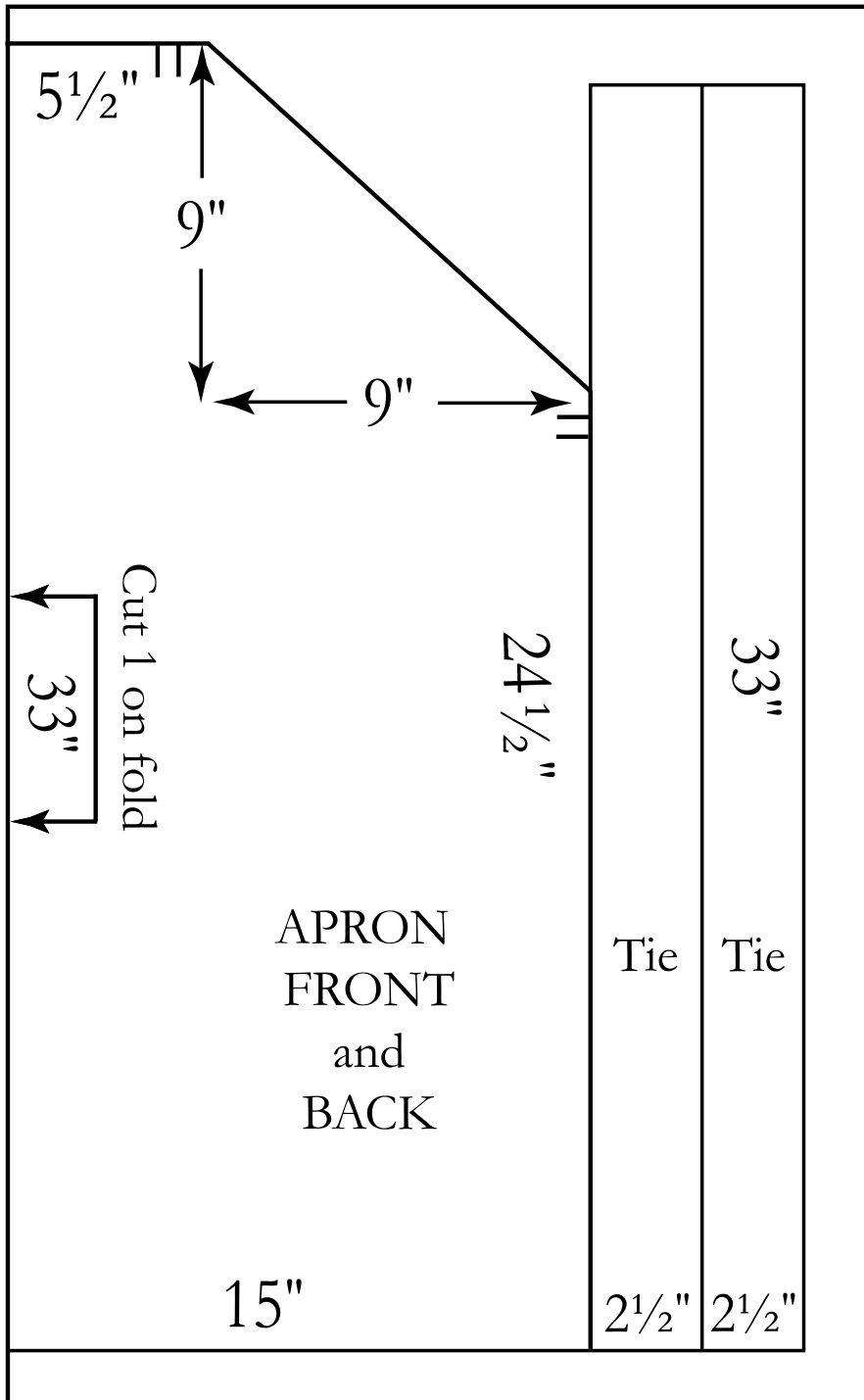
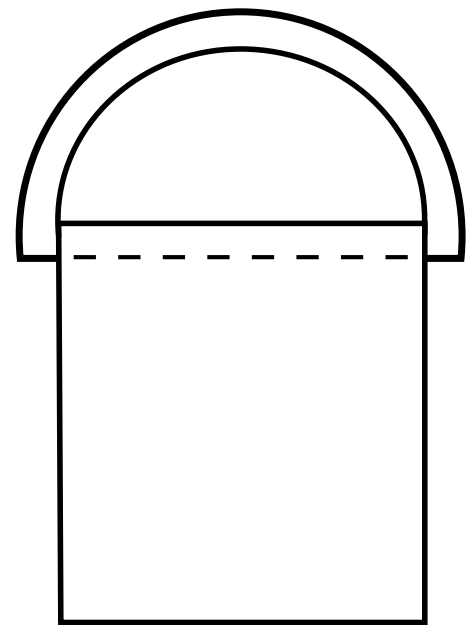
