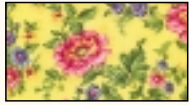

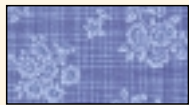

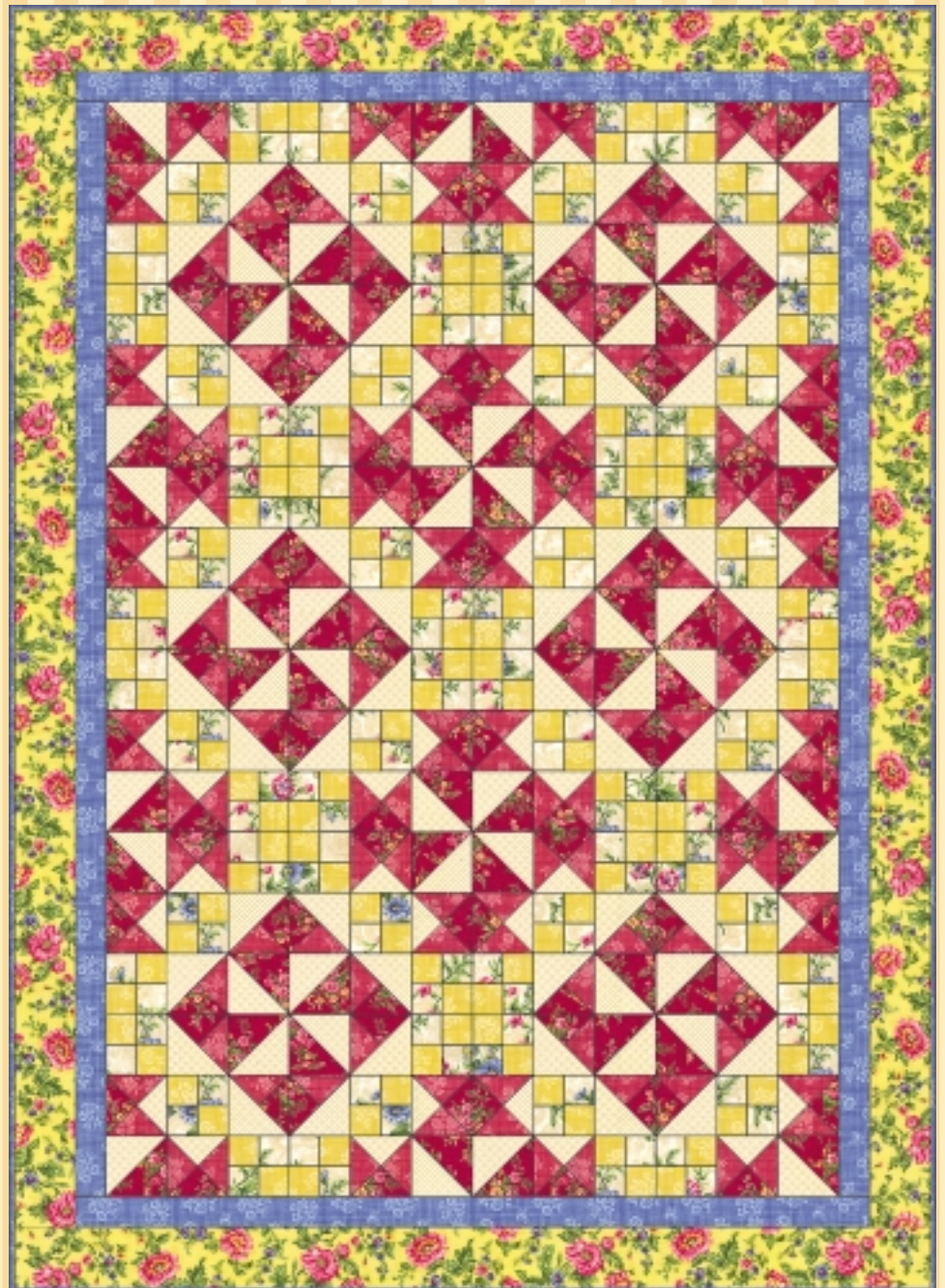

Materials Needed

Background (73020-E) 1-1/4 yd. Red (72971-R) 1 yd.

12 - 4 1/4" squares

24 - 4 1/4" squares

24 - 3 7/8" squares

24 - 3 7/8" squares

24 - 3 7/8" squares

Cut once on the diagonal

Pink (72973-D) 2/3 yd.

36 - 4 1/4" squares

Yellow (72973-S) 3/8 yd.

4 - 2" x 42" strips

Blue (72973-B) 1 yd.

5 - 2" x 42" (inside border)

6 - 2 1/2" x 42" (binding)

Beige Print (72971-E) 3/8 yd.

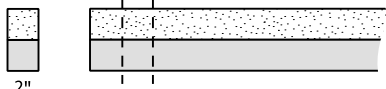
4 - 2" x 42" strips

Yellow Border (72970-Y) 1 yd.

6 - 4 1/2" x 42" strips

Sewing

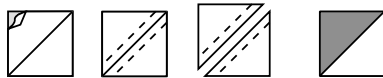
1. Make 4 strip sets using 2" x 42" beige strips and 2" x 42" yellow strips. Cut 144 - 2" units.



- A. Sew two units together to make 72 four-square blocks.



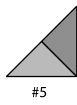
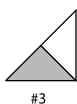
2. Place 24 - 3 7/8" background and red squares, right sides together. On background square, draw a diagonal line corner to corner. Sew 1/4" each side of line, cut apart on drawn line. Press to red.



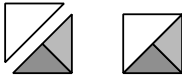
3. Place 12 - 4 1/4" background and pink squares, right sides together. On pink square draw a "X" corner to corner. Sew as shown in illustration, cut apart on all drawn lines. Press to pink.



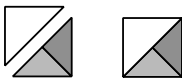
- A. Place 4 1/4" red and remaining pink squares right sides together. On six red squares, draw a "X" and sew as above. Press to pink.
- B. On 18 pink squares draw a "X" and sew as above. Cut apart, press to pink.



4. Sew background triangle and #4 together. Make 24. Press to #4.



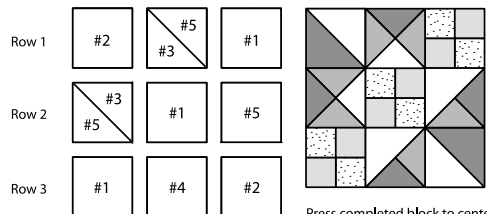
5. Sew background triangle and #5 together. Make 24. Press to background.



6. Sew #3 and #5 together. Make 48. Press to #3.

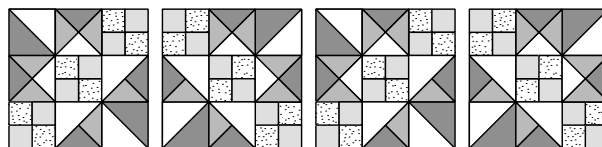


7. Using illustration as a guide sew rows together to make 24 blocks. Press rows 1 and 3 away from center and row 2 to center.



Press completed block to center.

8. Make six rows. Then assemble quilt alternating direction of each row.

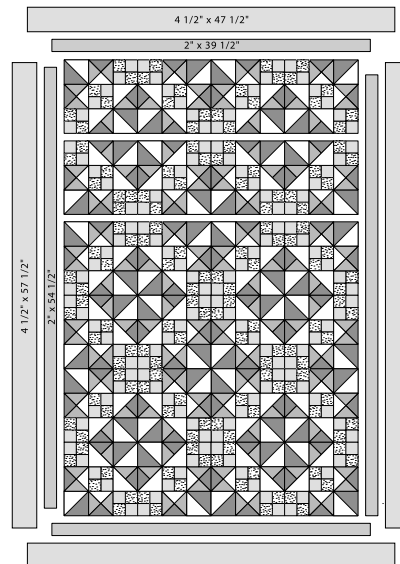


9. Sew borders to quilt. Always add sides first, then top and bottom, starting with inside borders working to the outside borders.

10. Layer quilt and bind.
