

WINDOW STRIP QUILT

Finished size 46" x 51" - 100% cotton - Textures/Blenders Collections

Pattern Level: Easy - Please press carefully step by step. Read through all instructions before beginning.

1/4" Seam allowances are used throughout and have been added.



Materials needed:

- 1/8 yard V0184-N Dark Navy
- 1/8 yard V0194-S Light Gold
- 1/8 yard V0184-V Wine
- 1/8 yard V0194-B Medium Blue
- 1/4 yard W6744-S Solid Gold
- 1/4 yard V0184-Q Blue Green
- 1/4 yard V0187-G Light Blue Green
- 3 1/2 yards W6744-R Wine Solid for Binding, Backing and Border
- 1/3 yard V0183-Y Blue Violet for Border
- 1/3 yard W6744-F Green Solid for Border
- 1/3 yard V0187-N Light Medium Blue for Border
- 1/4 yard V0191-S Dark Gold for Border
- 1/3 yard V0187-F Light Olive for Border
- 1/3 yard V0185-F Dark Olive for Border
- 1/8 yard V0189-W Gray Blue
- 1/3 yard W6744-B Denim Blue Solid for Border
- 1/8 yard V0185-E Tan
- 1/8 yard W6744-X Light Blue Solid
- 1/4 yard V0185-V Purple for Border
- 1/8 yard V0192-K Light Gray
- Twin sized batt
- Threads to match
- Rotary cutter and board

Cutting Instructions

1. DN - Dark navy
Cut 2 strips 2" x 45" for rows F and J.
Cut 1 square 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 2 half square triangles.
2. LGD - Light Gold
Cut 2 strips 2" x 45" for rows F and J.
Cut 3 squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 6 half square triangles (You need 5, one is extra).
3. W- Wine
Cut 2 strips 1" x 45" for spacer rows A and O.
Cut 2 squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 4 half square triangles (You need 3, one is extra). Cut 4 strips 1" x 6-1/2" for top and bottom borders. Cut 2 Strips 2" x 45" for rows F and J.
4. MB - Medium Blue
Cut 2 strips 2" x 45" for rows F and J.
Cut 1 square 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 2 half square triangles.
Cut 1 strip 1-1/2" x 45" for row H.
5. SG - Solid Gold
Cut 4 strips 2" x 45" for rows F and J, and rows B and N.
Cut 1 square 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 2 half square triangles.
6. BG - Blue Green
Cut 2 strips 1-3/4" x 45" for rows B and N.
Cut 3 strips 2" x 45" for rows F and J.
Cut 1 strip 1-1/2" x 45" for row H.
Cut 1 square 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 2 half square triangles (You need 1, one is extra).
7. LBG - Light Blue Green
Cut 2 strips 1-3/4" x 45" for rows B and N.
Cut 3 strips 2" x 45" for rows F and J.
Cut 1 strip 1" x 45" for spacer rows G and I.
Cut 1 square 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 2 half square triangles.

8. WS - Wine Solid
Cut 10 strips 2" x 45" for rows B and N, rows F and J, and top and bottom borders.
Cut 2 strips 1" x 45" for rows B and N. Put aside remaining wine solid for binding and backing.
9. BV - Blue Violet
Cut 1 strip 2" x 45" for rows F and J.
Cut 2 strips 2-1/2" x 45" for side borders.
Cut 2 squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 4 half square triangles.
10. G - Solid Green
Cut 1 strip 2" x 45" for rows F and J.
Cut 2 strips 1-1/2" x 45" for side borders.
Cut 1 square 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 2 half square triangles.
Cut 2 strips 1" x 45" for spacer rows G and I.
11. LMB - Light Medium Blue
Cut 3 strips 2" x 45" for rows F and J, top and bottom borders.
Cut 1 strip 1-1/2" x 45" for row H
Cut 2 strips 2" x 45" for side borders.
Cut 2 squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 4 half square triangles (You need 3, one is extra).
12. DG - Dark Gold
Cut 2 strips 2" x 45" for rows F and J, top and bottom borders.
Cut 2 strips 1" x 45" for spacer rows E and K.
Cut 1 square 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 2 half square triangles.
13. LO - Light Olive
Cut 4 strips 2" x 45" for rows B and N, rows F and J, and top and bottom borders.
14. DO - Dark Olive
Cut 5 strips 2" x 45" for rows B and N, rows F and J, and top and bottom borders.
15. GB - Gray Blue
Cut 1 strip 2" x 45" for rows F and J.

Cut 2 squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 4 half square triangles (You need 3, one is extra).

16.DB - Denim Blue

Cut 4 strips 2" x 45" for rows B and N, and top and bottom borders

Cut 2 squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 4 half square triangles (You need 3, one is extra).

Cut 2 strips 1" x 45" for spacer rows C and M.

17.T - Tan

Cut 2 strips 1" x 45" for spacer rows E and K.

Cut 2 squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 4 half square triangles (You need 3, one is extra).

18.LB - Light Blue

Cut 3 squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 6 half square triangles.

19.P - Purple

Cut 2 strips 2" x 45" for top and bottom borders.

Cut 3 squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 6 half square triangles (You need 5, one is extra).

20.LG - Light Gray

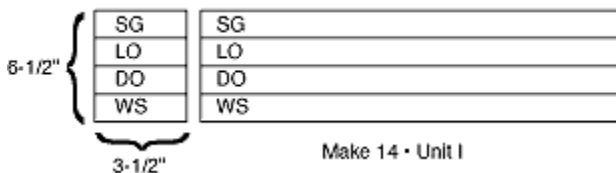
Cut 2 squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8", Cut in half diagonally to make 4 half square triangles (You need 3, one is extra).

ROWS B and N

Unit I

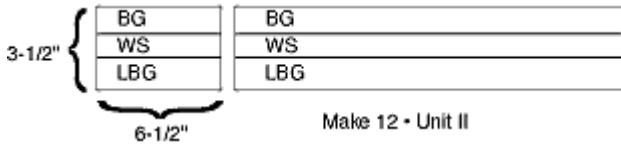
Sew 2" strips of SG, LO, DO, WS together lengthwise.

Cut into 3-1/2" segments as pictured.

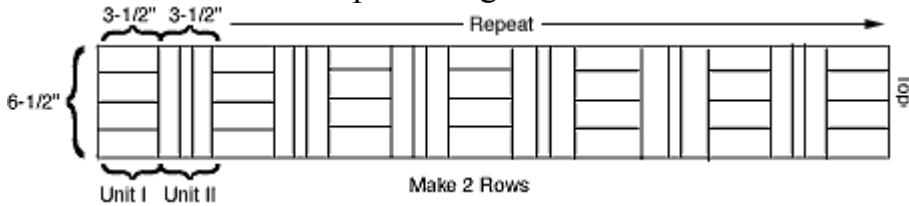


Unit II

Sew 1-3/4" strip BG, 1" strip WS and 1-3/4" strip LBG together lengthwise. Cut into 6-1/2" segments as pictured.



Sew **Unit I** and **Unit II** pieces together as shown to form 2 rows.

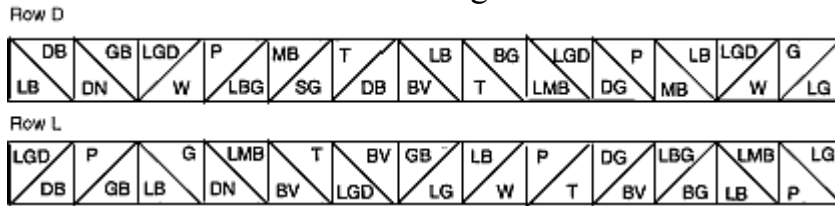


ROWS D and L

Sew triangles together to form squares.

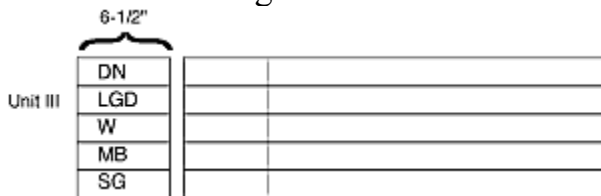


Sew squares together into rows as shown. Please note row L triangles are reversed. These rows of 13 triangles should measure 39-1/2"

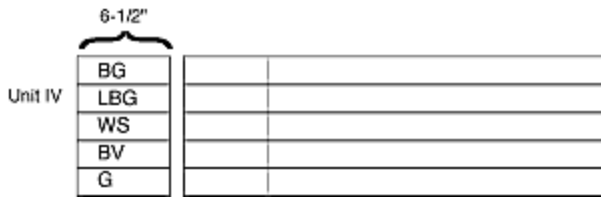


ROWS F and J

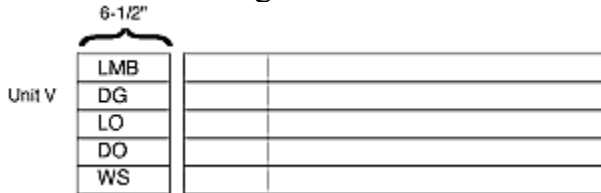
Sew 2" strips together lengthwise as follows:
Make 2 6-1/2" segments.



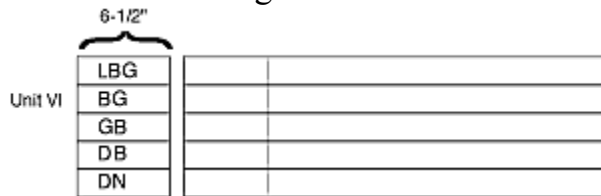
Make 2 6-1/2" segments.



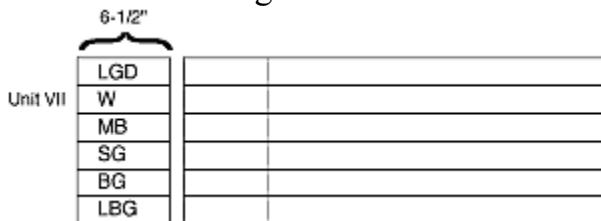

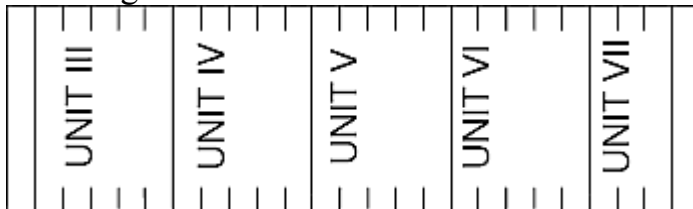
Make 2 6-1/2" segments.

A total of 26 strips should measure 39-1/2". Cut each unit into 6-1/2" segments. Piece together **Unit III** thru **Unit VII** to form rows F and J as pictured.



ROW H

Center row. Make 1.

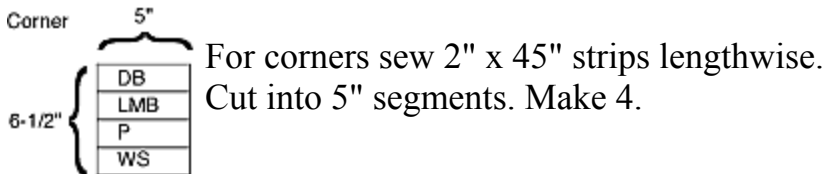
Sew together 1-1/2" strips of LMB, BG and MB as shown. Trim to 39-1/2".

Other rows should also equal 39-1/2"

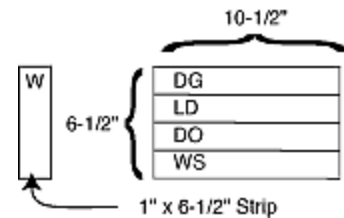

BORDERS

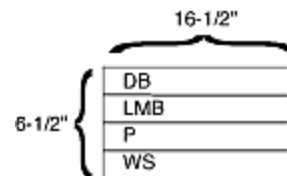
Top and Bottom



Sew 2" x 45" strips of each color lengthwise. Cut into 10-1/2" segments. Make 4.



Sew 2" x 45" strips of each color lengthwise. Cut into 16-1/2" segments. Make 2. Piece borders as pictured.



SIDE BORDERS

Sew strips together as shown. Trim to size of quilt. Should measure 39-1/2"

SIDE BORDERS	
G	1-1/2" x 40"
LMB	2" x 40"
BV	2-1/2" x 40"

SPACER ROWS A, C, E, G, I, K, M, O.

Spacer strips were cut 1" x 45".

Measure your other completed rows and trim spacer strips to this measurement. (Should measure 39-1/2").

Spacer rows A and O = Color W

Spacer rows C and M = Color DB

Spacer rows E and K = Alternate colors DG and T (See photo) Spacer rows G and I = Alternate colors LBG and G (See photo)

Cutting and Sewing tips for 1" spacer strips

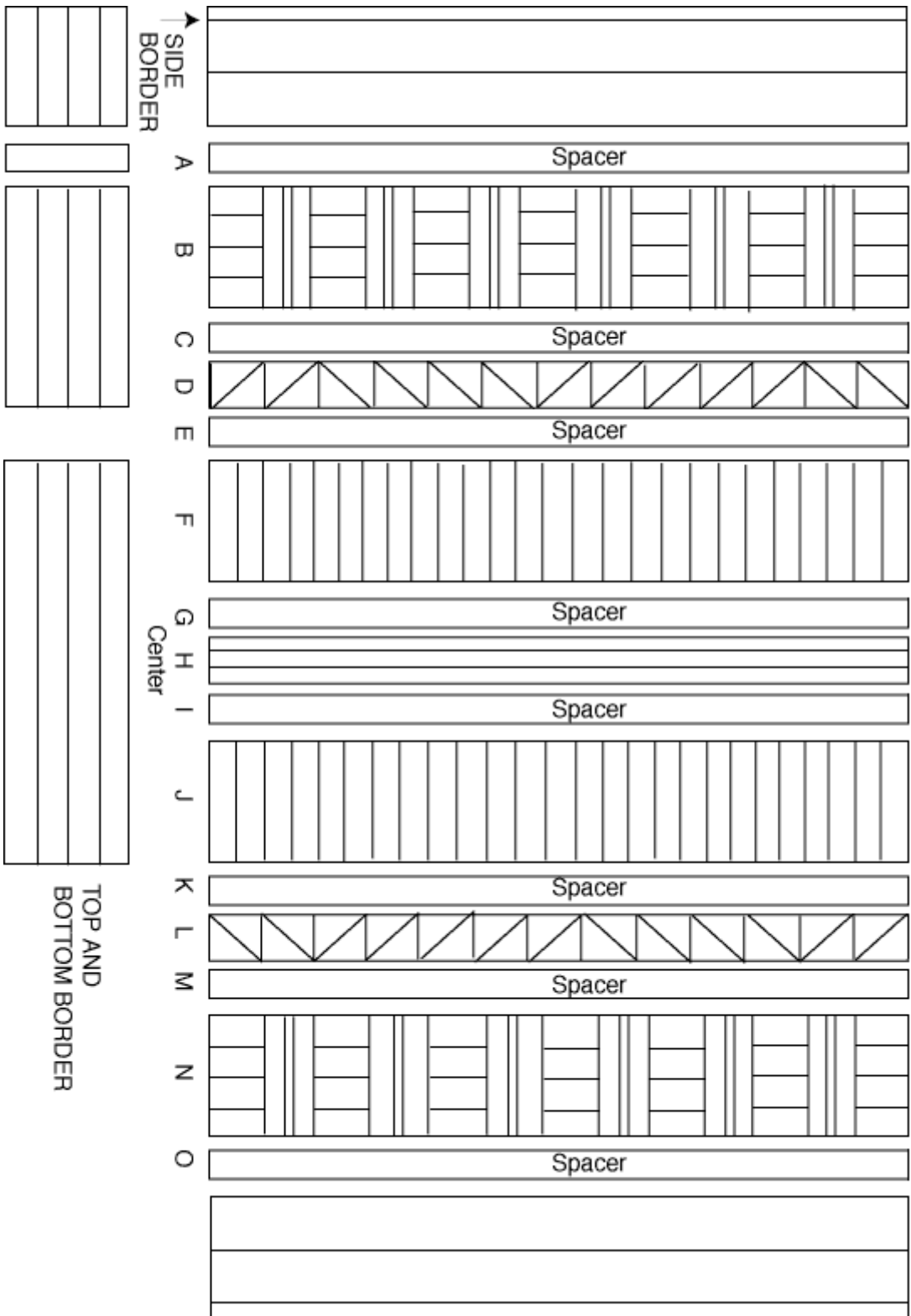
Sew 1" strip to larger piece. Press towards larger piece. Sew other side - press

away from spacer strip.

Center diamonds are cut 3" square and appliquéd onto center using color WS. Wrong side of fabric was used for top and bottom triangles and small center square in overlapping diamonds. Machine appliquéd on center strips as shown.

Refer to layout diagram and photographs for row placement. When all rows are complete, they are sewn together in strips vertically. There are 15 rows including 1/2" spacers. When rows are sewn together add side borders. Then add borders top and bottom adding corners at each end.

When top is complete cut batting and backing 2 inches larger than top on all sides. The back will have to be pieced. Assemble the quilt sandwich by placing the backing, batting and top together in layers and pin or baste with pins. Machine quilt in all seam lines and as otherwise desired. When quilting is complete, trim all sides and bind in the usual manner. Yardage for binding has been included. Color WS.
